In addition to achieving our expectations of safety and security, it allows us to minimize the crime rate on campus and ensure an environment of peace and order. It is important that the incident or offense is narrated clearly and precisely including the following information

- Place of occurrence
- Time
- Place where you last saw the suspect
- Characteristics of suspect (gender, race, approximate age, approximate weight, color and length of hair, color of eyes, hair, facial features, clothes, shoes, tattoos and scars)

Área de Seguridad

The Area of Internal Security, attached to the Office of General Services, is the institutional body responsible for safety on campus. This area works in the implementation of security measures in compliance with the policies established in coordination with the private security company and the various administrative and academic units of the UCB. Our role is to provide a suitable and safe environment for students, faculty, administrative staff and the general public.



Among our responsibilities are controlling pedestrian and vehicle access, physical inspections of facilities, ensuring the safety of our university community and investigating crimes. * The Security Office

Preventive Security Measures

- Avoid routine routes,;when walking select new routes.
- If you ask for directions, do not go near the car.
- Do not carry more money than necessary.
- If you see something suspicious, report it quickly to a security guard or pólice.
- Be sure to lock your car. Protect it with an alarm or any other device that make it difficult to steal.
- Do not leave valuables inside your car in plain sight.
- Before entering your vehicle, check the area around the car.
- When going to your car, have the keys at hand; do not wait to look for them.
- Keep you the university ID card with you at all times.
- Do not stay inside your vehicle in the parking lot of the institution.
